A bus to Helmsley

From Thirsk, Northallerton, Easingwold and local villages you can now take a bus on Sundays and Bank Holidays to Helmsley with connections to many other parts of the North Yorks Moors. For example leaving Thirsk Market Place at 10.43 travel on the M5 Moorsbus via Coxwold, Byland Abbey and Ampleforth to Helmsley, arriving at 11.20. The M4 bus connects, leaving at 11.30 for Rievaulx Abbey. You could stay on the bus to Great Ayton and beyond but let's assume you get off to look around the abbey or take a walk. The M4 at 14.12 from Rievaulx will take you all the way back to Thirsk - or get off in Helmsley to stay for two hours to visit the Walled Garden and return to Thirsk on the M5 bus, leaving at 16.30. Now, there is a recipe for a great day out without the car!

It is just one of many plans you can make with the Moorsbus timetable, available now in Thirsk's information centre.

Moorsbus is organised by just a few people running a charity but the services they contract are run by local bus companies. Because the services are nationally registered, English bus passes can be used on the Moorsbuses. However, please donate on the bus or at www.localgiving.org because Moorsbus cannot survive without donations.

North Yorkshire Show

The 40th North Yorkshire County Show will be held at Camp Hill Estate DL8 2LS between Carthorpe and Kirklington some eight miles south of Bedale and adjacent to the A1, on Sun 17 Jun from 8am.

There will be many exciting displays and demonstrations plus a whole range of Main Ring Attractions, Classic Cars and Motorcycles, A Fun Dog Show, Cattle, Sheep and Poultry, Rabbits, Cavies, Hamsters and Ferrets, Bungee Trampolines, Country Pursuits, Carriage Driving, Horticulture and Produce, Arts, Crafts, Photography, and the Yorkshire

Country Women's Association & Children's Classes.

The Carriages will make a main ring appearance in the afternoon and there will be the usual Grand Parade of Cattle and Class winners followed by classic cars, vintage agricultural machinery. Also at the show will be the Yorkshire Food Marquee, Craft Marquee, a wide variety of Trade Stands, and on-site Catering including Ice Cream, and a Real Ale Bar.

Dogs will be admitted to the show with owners, provided that they are kept on a lead at all times.

Fireworks Championship

On 21st July at Newby Hall near Thirsk, Ripon and Boroughbridge three of the UK's best firework companies compete against each other and you, the audience, votes by text.

When the gates open at 5pm relax in the grounds & soak up the unique atmosphere. In the hours before the shows start you can choose a spot to setup your chairs, tables and food, relax and listen to the background music and interviews with the firework teams. There will also be a selection of food and drink available to buy from the vendors on site. There are some fairground rides for the kids. At 9.20pm enjoy a real time lesson in

pyromusical choreography where various fireworks are fired and discussing over the PA system - how they work and where they are used. At 9.50pm the three competing teams will each fire a 10 minute display set to music with a 5 minute interval between shows. Text voting opens once the last display has fired. Afterwards MLE Pyrotechnics will fire a closing display which is not subject to the rules and limits of the competitors and results will then be announced. All entry to the event closes at 8:30pm for safety reasons.
