Until Sat 4 Apr Thirsk's Zillah Bell Gallery is displaying the full suite of 52 prints, 'Against Nature', by the internationally acclaimed artist, William Tillyer, who commented:

"I'm delighted the complete suite of works can be seen again in its entirety for the first time since 2018."

The artworks are all inspired by Joris-Karl Huysmans' experimental novel, 'A Rebours', and use a wide range of different intaglio printmaking techniques. Tillyer, who first began the project in 1974, continued to work on it during the next 43 years.

William Tillyer was born and still works in North Yorkshire. He studied at Middlesbrough College of Art and at the Slade. He has exhibited internationally and his work is held in the collections of The Museum of Modern Art, New York; the Brooklyn Museum; the Tate Gallery, the V&A and the Arts Council.
